- 1. What do you notice about the way this student has planned their answer? There are at least 5 points to make.**
- 2. Which quotations do you think he used to form his PEE (Point, Evidence, Explanation) Use your set scenes to help you.**

Plan:

Intro ideas: Not many people would dare to question a man like Richard...

Where?	Person who questions?	Richard's Reaction/Response?
1 st set scene	Hastings casts doubt on Richard's claim that his deformity is a result of witchcraft	Outrage/Change of personality/Richard has him beheaded
2 nd set scene	Mayor of London questions Richard and Buckingham's lies that Hastings was plotting to kill them	Insulted/Enraged/Furious/Richard is outraged at the suggestion and verbally attacks the Mayor
3 rd set scene	Buckingham indirectly questions Richard's suggestions to kill Edward by asking for time to think instead of agreeing straight away	Suspicious/Distrustful/Wary/Richard decides not to promote Buckingham and to ostracise him

Conclusion ideas: Dangerous to question Richard and the responses are frightening and manipulative so...
