I am writing on behalf of David Spurdle, who is at present visiting Nepal on behalf of Kids Alive, to thank you for your most generous gift, which I believe, came to us via the School Fund. I was given to understand that they had some funds left over which they distributed between three charities. I should be grateful if you would pass on our gratitude to everyone concerned in making Kids Alive the beneficiary of this gift.

We have allocated the donation to the work at the Bethany School in Bokoji, Ethiopia.

Kids Alive “adopted” the Bethany School in 2005 where 220 children shared two mud classrooms. There was no water, no toilets, no books, no pencils, no food and no smiles. However, things are changing and we now have four purpose built classrooms and 268 eager students who enthusiastically attend school every day. As the demand for places at our school continues to grow, we need to build four additional classrooms in order to change the lives of even more children caught in a downward vortex of illiteracy, poverty and hunger, resulting in a life seemingly without hope or purpose.
