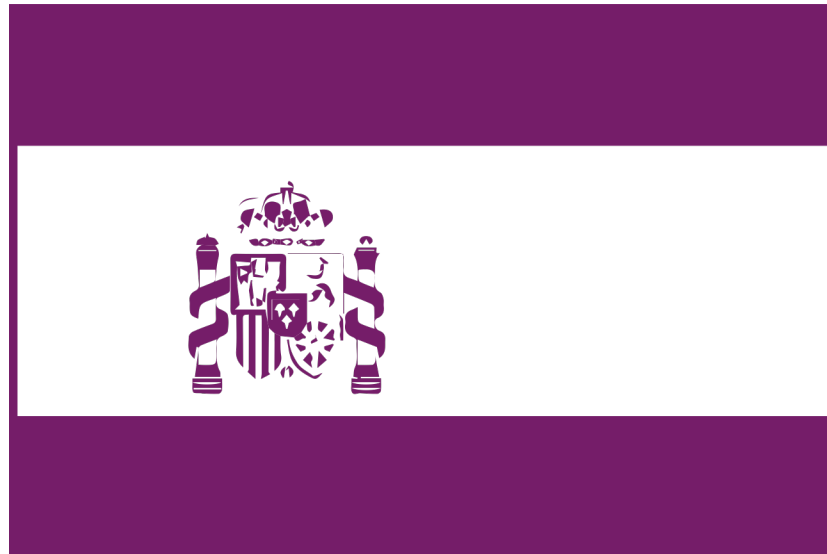


# Seating Plans

# Late

- If a student is late to school, you sign in at the main school office.
- If students receive 3 late marks, a late detention is issued after school on the day of a students' assembly. This is for 30 minutes.



# Form Groups

- Form groups take into account gender, ability, sport and music attributes.
- Form groups consist of approximately 26-27 students per class.
- Students will make new friends within the first few weeks of school in year 7.





# Finding our way around

- Each form group will be assigned a Senior Prefect. The Senior Prefect will escort you to and from your lessons until you feel confident that you know your way around the school.
- If you do get lost, we encourage students to speak to a member of staff or to a prefect. You will recognise prefects as they wear white shirts.

# Homework

- Students will be issued with a homework timetable in the Autumn Term.
- You will have 1-2 homework set per evening. The expectation for students in the lower school is 30 minutes per homework.
- You will not be expected to complete the homework for the next day.
- Staff set homework on SIMs and parents are able to see homework that has been set by members of staff.



# Summer School / Meet the Tutor



- Students are welcome to attend our summer school - Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> – Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> August 2022. Further details to follow.
- Students will find out what house they are in after the May half term. Students will be sent an induction pack and a letter with the details in the post.
- Students are welcome to visit the school with their parent/carer for the ‘Meet the Tutor’ appointment in July. Details will be provided at our New Intake Information Evening on Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2022.
