Dear Year 7 (2022/23) Parent or Carer,

We are delighted to be running a Hall Mead Summer School 2022, following the huge success of last years. This will offer a great opportunity for students to familiarise themselves with the Hall Mead and meet new classmates. Hall Mead staff will be delivering a range of activities; academic and sporting from Monday 22nd to Wednesday 24th August. With no government funding for this to enable us to run Summer School 2022 the charge per day will be £30. Details of the payment method will be shared at our New Intake Evening on Thursday 23rd June that starts in the main school hall at 6.30pm.

Students will be grouped in the tutor groups they will be in next year so they can get to know their new class mates. Each day students should report to the Hall in our new block for a 9:30 start. We will introduce the day and make sure students know what they are doing and where they are going. Our new Year 11 Prefects will be on hand to guide them around the school. On Monday, we will give each child a timetable for the week so they can see the activities they are doing on each day.

Monday to Wednesday will have three one-hour sessions with a 15-minute break and then a lunch break between these sessions; students need to bring lunch with them. Please ensure that there is nothing containing nuts in your child's lunch. If they are entitled to free school meals, please email Mr Cole via kcole@elatschools.co.uk who can assist with this. The final session finishes at 2.00 pm. Each tutor group will have different lessons each day but most days will include PE so please ensure students are dressed appropriately for this; we have taken care to ensure all students get a similar diet across the week. If your child does miss any day(s) that will not compromise their start in the subjects missed as the activities are all extra to the curriculum that will be covered in Year 7.
