Welcome to Science

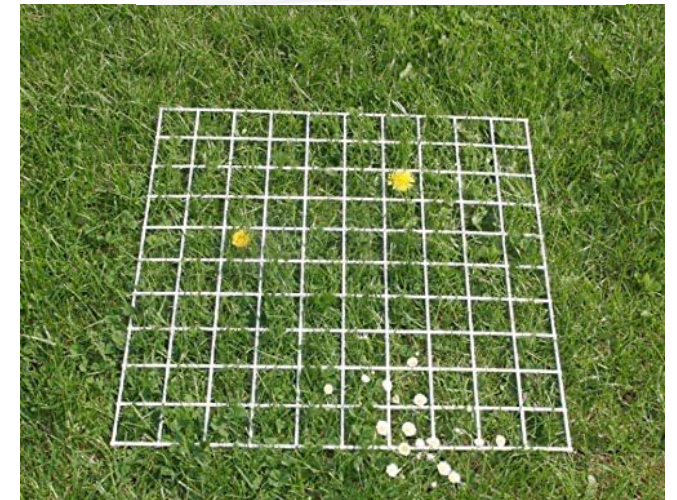


Things to bear in mind:

- On the next slide, there are a couple of pictures of a Science lab from Hall Mead School!

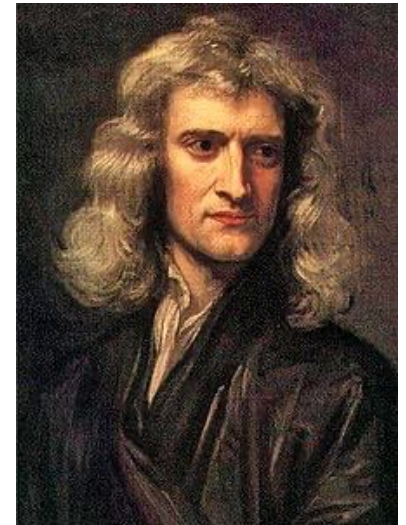
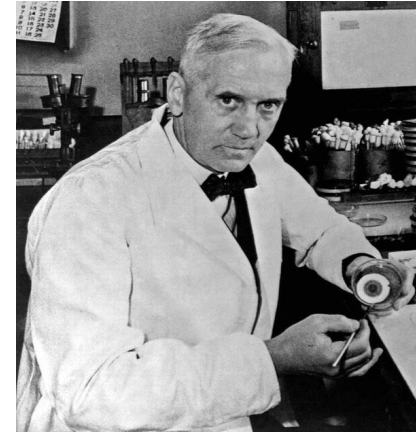
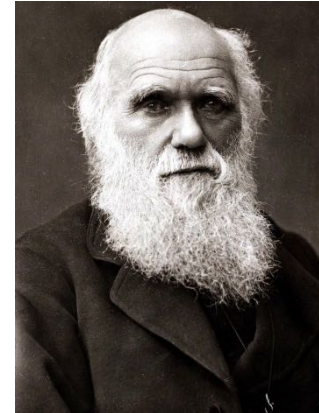
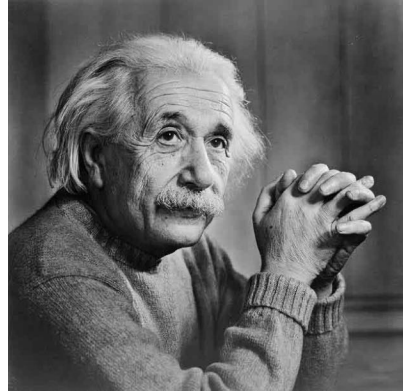
