Who we are

Mental Health Support Teams (MHSTs) are part of a national initiative developed by NHS England and the Department for Education aimed at supporting young people with their emotional wellbeing in a school or college setting.

Havering MHST are proud to be supporting young people in primary and secondary schools and colleges across the borough who may be experiencing mild to moderate difficulties with their wellbeing and mental health. We received feedback from young people about our team name, which is how we came to be Havering Emotional Support Team (HEST).

We have been working with schools since January 2022 and during this time we have had thousands of contacts with young people.



Following the introduction of a new team in September 2023, there are now three teams in Havering, which are overseen by the Clinical Lead Diana Daniel-Dawson. Each team has a Senior Clinical Supervisor, two Senior Mental Health Practitioners and four Educational Mental Health Practitioners (EMHPs). Our new trainee EMHPs embark on their training in October 2023. We are also supported by our amazing team administrator.
