


















Mrs Fanning—Golden Wristbands




Celebrating Year 11 Success Mr Leslie, Assistant Headteacher

too. Well done to these students!












Sparx Winners—Miss Towey, Director of Maths



Achievement Points—Mr Morritt, Head of Year 11 /




